

THE ROYAL SPANISH MOTORSPORTS FEDERATION'S POSITIONING REGARDING THE INVASION IN UKRAINE

On March 4th, the Royal Spanish Motorsports Federationcalled for an urgent meeting of its Board of Directors which concluded, in its only point of the meeting's agenda, in a clear position of accusation and rejection against Russia and Belarus, as the aggressor countries, and the maximum solidarity towards the invaded people of Ukraine.

Said positioning was materialized by RFEDA's Delegated Commission, which approved, unanimously, to <u>prohibit in national and international competitions</u> the participation of athletes, competitors, officials and any other <u>person/entity with a Russian or Belarussian sport license</u>, subject to taking <u>further and more extreme measures</u>, in case the war conflict provoked by <u>Russia continues escalating</u>. This decision will remain in place until the situation is resolved.

After learning the decision taken by the Delegated Commission, the president of the entity, Manuel Aviñó, stated: "the Royal Spanish Motorsports Federation, on behalf of our sport's whole collective in our country, shows its total support to the Ukrainian people and, especially, toUkraine's Motorsport Federation (FAU)."
